

Frequently Asked Questions about Donation Voting

Who is eligible to vote?

Everyone who holds shares on Monday 31 July 2023 (the record date) is eligible to vote.

When does voting open?

Voting opens on Friday 1 September 2023 at 5:00pm (Sydney time).

When does voting close?

Voting will close on Friday 29 September 2023 at 5:00pm (Sydney time).

How do I vote?

Shareholders will be emailed or mailed details on how to submit their vote using our online voting form.

Am I only able to vote online?

Yes. If you are unable to vote online, we can help you to complete the online form. Please call a member of the Future Generation team on (02) 9247 9202 for assistance.

How much will Future Generation invest?

This year, Future Generation Australia (ASX: FGX) will invest \$5.2 million^{*} and Future Generation Global (ASX: FGG) will invest \$5.4 million^{*}. This will bring Future Generation's total social investment since inception to \$75.9 million.

When will Future Generation make the donation payments?

Future Generation will make the donation payments in late November 2023.

Can I allocate my portion of the social investment to a not-for-profit organisation of my choice?

If you hold under one million shares, you can allocate your portion of the social investment to a Future Generation social impact partner or partners. To allocate to an organisation of your choice, you must hold over one million shares on the record date of Monday 31 July 2023. All organisations must have <u>Deductible Gift Recipient (DGR)</u> <u>status</u> to be eligible to receive donations.

Can I combine my Future Generation Australia and Future Generation Global holdings for voting?

Holdings cannot be combined across the Future Generation companies.
